Citizen: 1420 W. Farwell, Council for Jewish Elderly building: the city removed the two-car space and replaced with one that is now reserved. No space for wheelchair. Kevin will contact the Alderman's office for verification and see what can be done.

Citizen: What was the cause of the fire at Bar None? Electrical. Place is still closed.

IV. Identify new problem areas.

Citizen: Concerns about park district garbage trucks, park district employee traffic that are not watching out for pedestrians. How can we reduce the amount of motor vehicles in the park? Sgt. Baranowski: There is no minimum number of police cars that can be on the beach at a given time. Kevin: Address this with Mary at the Park District.

Citizen: Pratt Avenue is residential parking only, and the lifeguards are using those spots instead of walking down from Touhy.
