# Commercial Burglaries 024th District (Rogers Park)

#### **About the Crime:**

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 24<sup>th</sup> District (Rogers Park) of several Burglaries of commercial businesses. In each incident, the offenders make entry by smashing the windows to the front doors.

#### **About the Offender:**

Offenders smash the glass windows to the front entry doors to gain entry to the businesses. Once inside the Offenders break into the registers, and remove the money which was left in the registers.
